GREENBELT LAND



In a recent In Touch, Colin reported that he had been contacted by residents of Spinney Avenue who had heard rumours of proposals to build on the green belt land behind their properties. Colin investigated and found that no such plans existed – whether with Halton or Knowsley councils. However, Knowsley Council is considering plans to allow some development of green belt land in south Prescott. Colin will continue to fight any green belt development in Ditton Ward, monitor the situation and report back to residents.

Councillor Profile—Colin Rowan

Colin lives with his wife Ruth in Hough Green and has done for 18 years.

He and Ruth are both retired police officers and continue to work in voluntary capacities for Victim Support, SSAFA - the ex-servicemen's



association - and the RAF Benevolent Fund. Colin is also vice chairman of governors at Ditton Primary School.

As a long time local resident, Colin has been dismayed at how the area has been ignored for so long by this Labour council. Colin notes: "When I was elected in 2004, I defeated a Labour councillor who lived in Runcorn. What could he possibly know about our area? The problems my neighbours encounter are those I have to deal with myself".

WORKING ALL YEAR ROUND

Together with his Conservative colleagues, Cllr Colin Rowan works for the local community all year round – not just at election time.

Colin comments: "Like everyone else, I have always been appalled when someone knocks on my door or delivers a leaflet asking for votes just weeks before an election – never to be heard from again for the rest of the year!
